NOTICE TO MARINERS FIRTH OF FORTH FORTH REPLACEMENT CROSSING COMMISSIONING AND TESTING OF NAVIGATION LIGHTS ON QUEENSFERRY CROSSING

Ref: Charts BA 728, 736

Commencing on Thursday 24th May 2018 for a period of 7 days, the Queensferry Crossing will undergo commissioning and testing of new navigation lights. This will result in inconsistent navigation lights being displayed during daylight hours.

A total of 18 new marine navigation lights will be made operational between the 24th and 31st May, as marked up in red squares and red circles the attached drawing.

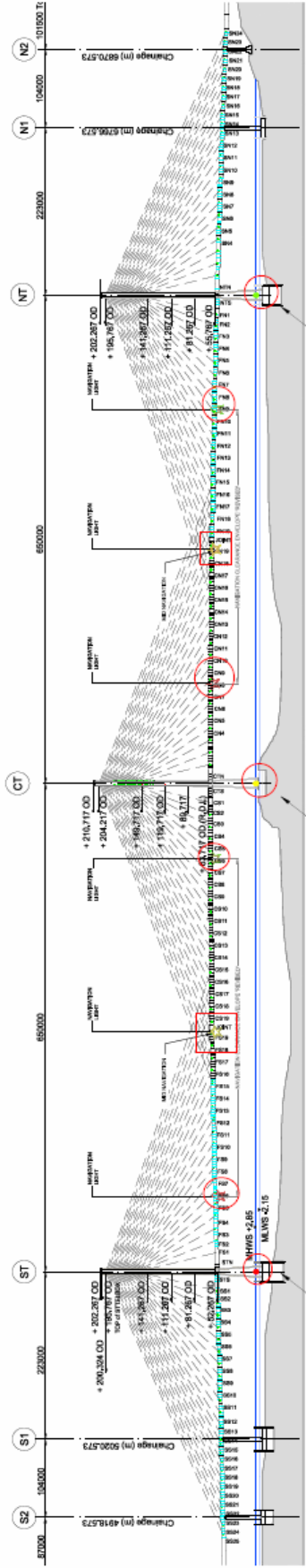
The red squares indicate the 4 temporary lights that will be extinguished and replaced with 4 new permanent lights on the 24th May. These new lights will be operational on 24th May and remain on during the hours of darkness, but may be inconsistent during the day up to 31st May while the full system is being complete and commissioned.

The red circles show the remaining 14 new permanent lights that will be made operational and commissioned from 25th May to 31st May.

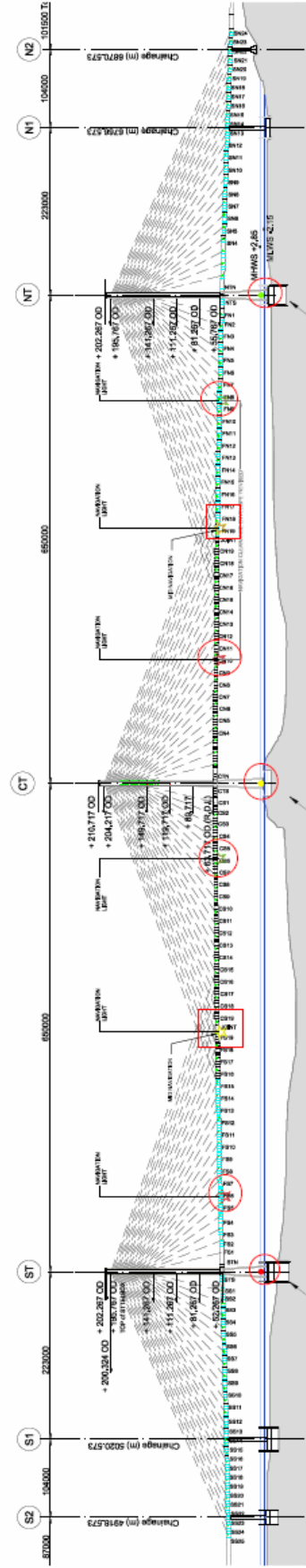
Status of previously published notices:
