

Dedicated railhead located within London Container Terminal providing efficient turnaround of trains with direct connection to the UK rail network.

Infrastructure & Facilities

RAIL DETAILS

- 20 x 60 foot decks max (16 without a rearrangement)
- 460m of straddle accessible track, spilt into 4 workable areas each containing 4/5 wagons for a quick turn around
- Ability to shunt wagons within terminal
- Capability to handle 20, 30, 40 & 45ft containers


