

Ports of Tilbury and Tilbury2 Notice to Mariners – No. 04 of 2021

VESSEL HOT WORKS REQUEST

THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO HOT WORKS ON BOARD AND WITHIN THE CONFINES OF VESSELS ONLY.

All Hot Works on board vessels MUST be authorised by the Marine Department prior to works taking place. Hot Works requests should be made with 24 hours' notice. There is no requirement for a Fire License for Hot Works on board vessels.

- 1. Master/Agent to complete 'Hot Works Request' form, available from marine.department@potll.com or Forth Ports website
- 2. Master/Agent to submit completed form to the Marine Department with 24 hours' notice; <u>marine.department@potll.com</u>
- 3. Marine Department will respond with an authorisation or a reason for rejection
- 4. Once authorised, permit will be valid for the described Hot Works only
- Marine Department must be informed prior to and on completion of the Hot Works: VHF 04 call sign TILBURY CONTROL or, +44 (0) 1375 852 456

In exceptional circumstances, Hot Works can be authorised with less than 24 hours' notice but this is at the discretion of the Asset and Marine Department and cannot be guaranteed.

Hot Works Requests at Tilbury Landing Stage will normally be refused due to the wooden construction. In an emergency, additional mitigations can be considered on a case by case basis.
