**Permit To Manoeuvre Craft within the Ports Limits**

This permit is issued in conjunction with Port of Tilbury Marine guidelines and Information.

This “Permit” has three sections:-

1. Specific Persons of which The Port of Tilbury recognises as Berthing Advisors
2. A vessel less than 80m in length
3. Persons Exempted from Berthing Assistance / Advice for a specific Vessel

**Note**, The Asset Manager Mariner or delegate can and will suspend or revoke a permit if it is deemed in the Ports interest to do so. This permit is valid for a period not exceeding one year, providing the supporting documentation remains valid. All Permit holders will report any Marine Incident using the report form found at [FPG-PMSC-F-07 08-Marine-Report-Form.docx \(live.com\)](#)
