How to Report:

- 1. **SPOT IT:** If you witness a near miss or a safety observation, no matter how minor, report it!
- 2. **REPORT IT:** Include as much information as possible, such as the location, time, weather, and nature of the near miss or observation & send an email to **Harbourmaster@potll.com**
- 3. **Prevent IT:** Your simple action today, can make the port safer tomorrow.

We value your input, and by reporting near misses or safety observations, you contribute to the continuous improvement of safety at the Port of Tilbury.
